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This Month's Topic: LCME Institutional Self Study Begins

Last month, the School of Medicine launched a key milestone toward achieving reaccreditation in 2019: the beginning of a faculty-led institutional self-study.

The goal of this study is to carefully examine the school's compliance with accreditation standards and provide recommendations for improvement.

The institutional study is led by a LCME Task Force cochaired by Dean Talmadge King, MD and Karen Hauer, MD, PhD, Faculty Accreditation Lead, and consists of five subcommittees. Each subcommittee is co-chaired by an Education Faculty Dean/Director and a School of Medicine representative. The entire process will culminate in the completion of an Institutional Self Study in May 2018.

Over 150 students, faculty, staff and students will participate in this collaborative process, which spans the School of Medicine enterprise.

On November 17, 80 members of these subcommittees convened at Mission Hall to review data compiled from faculty and staff across the School of Medicine, to begin evaluating our compliance with over 96 elements. *View a gallery of photos from the event <u>here</u>.*
