## **New Education Innovations Funding Grants Awarded**

[The Haile T. Debas Academy of Medical Educators](#), in collaboration with the [UCSF Library and Center for Knowledge Management](#) and the [Center for Innovation in Interprofessional Education](#), is pleased to announce 16 new Education Innovations Funding grant awards for the 2014-2015 academic year. Totaling \$283,502, these intramural grants are expected to make significant contributions to curricular and educational excellence in the UCSF School of Medicine.

This collaboration was initiated by three UCSF programs that fund education innovations and addresses a range of priorities in education of students and trainees at UCSF. The call resulted in an unprecedented crop of strong proposals. Thus, we sought and identified additional funding partners, including the [School of Medicine Office of Medical Education](#) and the [Program for the Aging Century](#). Responsibility for reviewing the submissions was shared within the collaboration.

The Academy's Innovations Funding program, open to both Academy and non-Academy faculty, provides intramural grants for the development of new curricular programs and promotion of constructive curricular change. Since the program's inception, the Academy has awarded more than \$2 million to more than 100 projects.

The Library Instructional Grants Program has funded interprofessional education projects for the last 6 years, with co-funding from the IPE Center for the last 5. During this period, the Library-IPE programs have funded 50 projects for over \$300,000.
