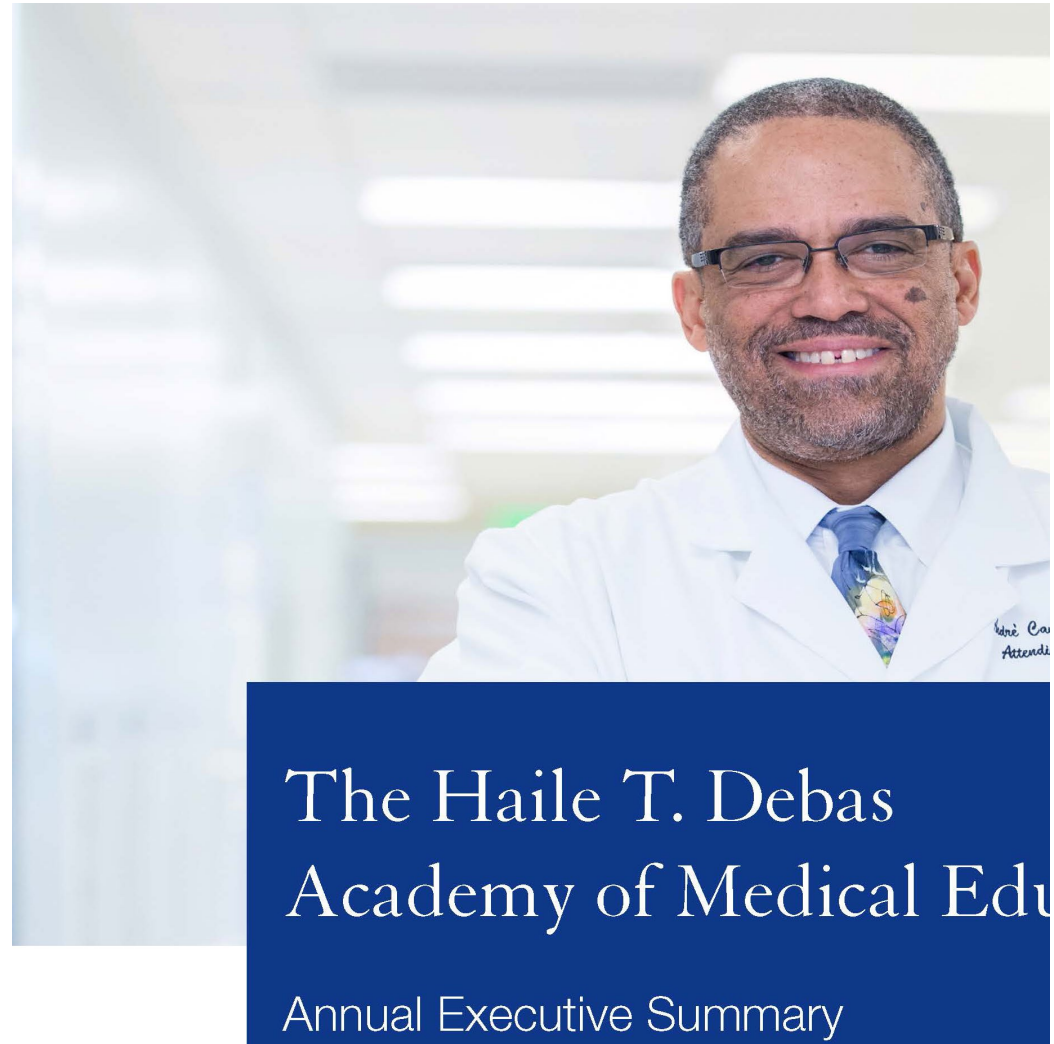
State of AME: 2022-2023

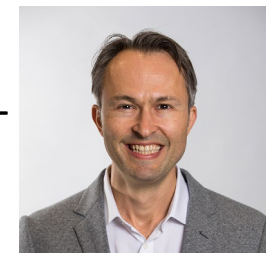

- The Academy's Innovations Funding program, open to all UCSF faculty, provides intramural grants for the development of new curricular programs and promotion of constructive curricular change.
- 2001-2023: Over \$4 million awarded to more than 275 projects.
- 2017-2023 Project total: 123
 - Unique PIs: 107
 - Departments: 25
 - Schools: 4
 - Total amount funded: > \$2,233,000

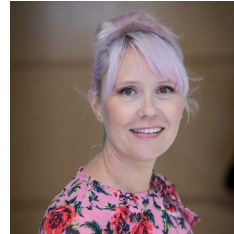
