

Faculty Development Summary 2020-2021

Key Points

- 110 UCSF Educational Skills Workshops and 12 Med Ed Grand Rounds lectures
- 133 faculty developers: 84 core, 23 copresenters, and 32 invited speakers
- 4.5 out of 5 mean overall session rating
- 3106 participants; 1098 unique individuals attending multiple sessions
- 25 participants per session, average
- All workshops live online as of March 17, 2020

The Teach for UCSF Certificate program, launched with 3 core tracks in 2013, provides a flexible way for faculty and trainees to develop their educational skills. Participants develop expertise in specific teaching theme areas by completing a series of Educational Skills Workshops.






Certificate Enrollments n=2535
