Carrot Eligibility

Enrolled in UC Residents/Fellows health plan & working 20 hours or more a week

Benefits are per resident/fellow and not member. Benefits may be used for any eligible member (even if not enrolled in health plan)

\$30,000 lifetime maximum

Carrot funds end upon separation from program for any reason. If return to residency or go on to a UC Fellowship the remaining Carrot funds will be available

COBRA available upon separation, but significant cost

Benefits effective 3/1/23

Carrot Benefits

Fertility preservation: egg retrieval, egg/sperm/embryo preservation

Treatment: IUI, IVF, donor sperm acquisition; egg and sperm storage

Testing & Diagnostics

Adoption & Surrogacy: related legal and agency costs

CarrotRx: specialty pharmacy for fertility medications
