Language Partners

Cachamsi: Non-profit based in Ecuador providing healthcare to indigenous people

- Pre-test and post-test assessment offered within program
- Dates and times are agreed upon by teacher and student
- Programs range from 2 hours/day x 5 days/week x 4 weeks (standard) to less intensive (2 days/week) to immersive (arrange with teacher).
- Students register and pay through the [Cachamsi website](#) for classes, after receiving the SOM Language Initiative funding.

Pop Wuj: Non-profit based in Guatemala, offers subsidized healthcare to local rural populations

- On-line teachers cover all levels of General or Medical Spanish
- Pre-test and post-test assessment offered within program
- Dates and times are agreed upon by teacher and student
- Programs range in cost and intensity. All are 1:1 teacher to student ratio

Testing Opportunities:

ALTA: This respected language company does validated testing for government agencies, businesses, and healthcare organizations (including Kaiser and other medical schools & residency programs). The UCSF Interpreting Services Department has developed a partnership with ALTA allowing students to test post-language study for certification. Students should be at a general professional level of proficiency before taking the exam. Those who pass will receive a Certified Bilingual Clinician designation for their identification badge. Interested students should send their names and email addresses to bilingual@ucsf.edu. There is no fee for the assessment.
