

UCSF School of Medicine Student COVID-19 External Volunteering / Work While Enrolled Registration

As the cases of COVID-19 in our communities rise, the top priorities for students are: safety, your health, protecting the public, protecting health care workers, and academic learning and engagement to support students' journeys to becoming outstanding UCSF physicians. No school credit will be offered for external volunteer activities at this time. External volunteer activities refers to any volunteer activity that is not supervised or sponsored by a UCSF faculty or staff member.

If you are enrolled in or participating in external volunteer, elective or paid activities that increase your risk of COVID-19, you must register with the UCSF School of Medicine by signing this form. We also strongly recommend that you register with the school if you are on a leave of absence and participating in volunteer or paid activities that increase your risk of COVID-19.

Checklist for Students Participating in External Volunteer or Paid Activities that Increase COVID-19 Risk

- You must be able to participate fully in the medical school curriculum and meet requirements for your courses/clerkships
- You must have health insurance
- You must have access to health care

- You must have appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) and full knowledge of how to use PPE

- Review local and state guidelines for shelter in place and quarantine
- If you have COVID-19 symptoms, you must contact UCSF Student Health; a period of self-quarantine will be required prior to returning to class or clinical activities.
- If you have a documented COVID-19 encounter, you must contact UCSF Student Health; a period of self-quarantine may be required prior to returning to class or clinical activities.
- You must work only at or below your level of competency in the clinical service you are providing
- You must have appropriate supervision by health professionals acting within their scope of practice
- You must have appropriate external malpractice coverage for the activities
- If you are operating as a health professional (nurse, EMT, etc.), your license must be active, and you must be volunteering within your scope of practice.
- You must notify financial aid if you are being paid for external activities.
